Excellent transportation continues to be one of Tukwila's strengths. Lying at the confluence of three ancient river valleys, Tukwila has always been a trading and transportation center. Today, Tukwila is one mile from the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, encompasses the juncture of Interstates 5 and 405, and is a few minutes from downtown Seattle and the seaport. Tukwila has excellent public transit including multiple bus routes, a Sounder commuter rail station, an Amtrak station, and a light-rail station.
